Over the course of the events, participants experience specifically designed programming to think critically, adapt to external pressures, and grow as leaders.

Both programs invest back into the District tenfold. Participants leave these programs with a positive experience with Rotary. Some go on to participate in other Rotary programs, join or start clubs, and be community stewards.
